Jammu and Kashmir Government -Notifications.

J&K STATE ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION, PDC COMPLEX, ASHOK NAGAR, SATWARI, JAMMU

Notification No.1 of 2007

Dated October 3, 2007

Pursuant to regulations 12,13,15 and 16 of the J&K SERC (Open Access in Intra-State Transmission and Distribution) Regulations, 2006 notified under No. 6/J&K/SERC/2006/Jammu 25-1-2006, the Jammu and Kashmir State Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby notifies that:-

1. Reg. No.12 (A) – Transmission / Distribution (Wheeling Charges):

The ST-rate applicable for Northern Regional CTU System shall be applied for determination of the transmission / distribution charges during FY 2007-08.

2.Reg. No.12 (D) – Cross-subsidy Surcharge:

During FY 2007-08 cross subsidy surcharge shall be nil.

3. Reg. No.12 (C) Additional Surcharge:

The additional surcharge shall be fixed case to case basis keeping in view the amount of fixed capacity cost allowed to distribution utility / licensee.

4. Reg. No.12 (D) Scheduling and System Operation Charges:

Rs. 1000/- per day or part there of shall be paid by short term Open Access user.

Rs. 30,000/- per month or part of the month shall be paid by long term Open Access user.

Note: - The operating charges include fee for scheduling and system operation fee for affecting revisions in schedule on bonafide grounds and collection and disbursement charges.

5. Reg. No. 12 (E) – Reactive Energy Charges:

If the voltage at the point of drawal is below 97% of the normal voltage, the Open Access customer shall pay @ 6 paise/KVARH to the concerned utility / licensee for drawal of reactive energy at the drawal point. If at the injection point the voltage is higher than 103% of normal voltage, the Open Access customer shall pay @ 6 paise / KVARH to the concern utility / licensee for injection of reactive energy at the point of injection. Both drawal and injection of reactive energy shall be measured at 15 minutes time block along with voltage.

6.Reg. No.12 (F) Restoration Charges:

Shall be decided from case to case basis.

7. Reg. No. 12(G) Any other Charges:

Access to Transmission and /or Distribution System Charges. - If a transmission service provider constructs a dedicated system for connecting supply point and / or delivery point to its network, the entire service charges for the same shall be borne by the Open Access customer. The charges for the dedicated system shall be in addition to the Open Access charges for the rest of the transmission and / or distribution system.

8. Reg. No. 13 –UI Charges under Intra-State ABT Tariff:

The commercial settlement of UI charges under intra-state ABT shall be done according to inter-state ABT Regulations.

9. Reg. No. 15 - Energy Loss:

The average technical loss allocable and to be considered for Open Access users during FY 2007-08 shall be as under:-

Transmission Losses (EHV)	5%
Distribution Losses (HV) (Excluding LV & MV)	5%

10. Reg. No. 15 – Special Energy Meter:

Charges for rental of meter (if provided by the utility / licensee), charges for meter reading and other related charges including the charge for communicating the meter reading to SLDC shall be paid by the Open Access customers @ Rs. 1000/- (rupees one thousand only) per month for each meter and shall be paid to the utility / licensee who is rendering such services.
