ORDER

(Passed on this 25th Day of November, 2014)

The case was last heard on 10th of July of 2014 at Srinagar. The PDD as usual had not complied with the directions issued vide this Commission's order dated 10th March, 2014. The DC(P) had sought one month's time to file the status report and the Commission had granted one month's time to the Utility directing it to submit the report by 10th of August, 2014. The case was fixed for hearing on 9th of September, 2014. However due to the floods in Srinagar, the case could not be heard.

The Utility has become a habitual defaulter and has not submitted the said report on the points dealt in the order till date. Taking a serious view of non-compliance of the directions issued by this Commission, the DC(P) is directed to explain as to why action under Section 102 of the

Electricity, 2010 be not initiated against the Utility. The Commission again directs the respondent (PDD) to file compliance report within four weeks.

The case is next fixed for hearing on 7th January, 2015.
